Occupy San Angelo 99%ers are planning a project designed to elicit assurance from local elected officials that public funds are on deposit at banking institutions that are not part of a national corporation.

J.B. Hall, coordinator of the group, is working with other members to develop a "letter of encouragement" whose purpose is to assure that city and county officials deposit monies with local businesses, if that is not the case already.

The local 99%ers have staged several public demonstrations. In addition, they have left statements at Representative Conaway's local office in support of services to low-income citizens and the necessity for maintaining public programs.
